

CDC Building 23

The CDC Building 23 laboratory replaced all outdated CDC biological laboratories, including the oldest laboratory buildings on CDC's main campus. Building 23 enhances CDC research on malaria, parasitic diseases, Salmonella, and E. coli, maintain PulseNet (the national DNA "fingerprint" library of foodborne diseases) and support AIDS research.

Approximately \$100,000 pieces of Shurjoint grooved product were used on this 16-story, 730,000 square foot building's domestic water supply system.
