

Tokyo City Hall

Tokyo Metropolitan Government Building, also known as Tokyo City Hall or Tocho, is located in Shinjuku, and was constructed during the period of April 1988 and March 1991. It was once the tallest building in Japan from 1991 to 2006 with a height of 248 meters.

Thanks to Kenzo Tange, a world-famous construction company, the Shurjoint grooved joining method was introduced for the first time in the Japanese fire protection market as it did not require a “fire watch”, as required in a welded system. Part of this building used Shurjoint #7705 couplings as a trial in 1990 for their ability to accommodate for seismic activity.
